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To all whom it may concern be it known that we Amelia
Lentium, Theodore Lentium, John Lentium, Alastair
Lentium and Thomas Lentium of Anne Arundel County
in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and
considerations us thereto moving have released from slavery
liberated and manumitted and set free and by these presents
do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set
free our negro man named Thomas Ogle being of the age
of forty three years. and able to work and gain a
sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said
negro man named Thomas Ogle we do declare to be
hereafter free manumitted and discharged from all
manner of service or servitude to us our executors or
administrators forever. Provided nevertheless that the said
negro man Thomas Ogle conducts and demean himself
as a good citizen otherwise he forfeits the freedom hereby
