 truly Content and pay Noevertheless the said Deft his promises & assumptions
 as in forme as made little minding or regarding but plotting & fraudulently
 intending him the said ptt in his behalfe craftily & subtilly to receive & to fraud
 the said five hundred pounds of Tobacco to the Deft altho' as he required the Deft
 the thirteenth day of Feby in the year as at the parish County and
 Jurisdiction as aforesaid. Since by the said ptt hath been thereto required hath
 not paid nor to him for the same he hath not any wife contented but to him self to pay
 he hath thereto refused & still doth refuse wherefore he says he is wrong and hath damage to
 the value of one thousand pounds of Tobacco & thereupon he brings this bill.

AND the said Deft being called came. And the said ptt by his atty prayed
 that the said Deft might give special baile to the said Court which is granted
 and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall
 give special baile as aforesaid. And the said Deft saith that he cannot give
 the Court as of him the said ptt. nor but that he did promise to pay the
 said sume of five hundred pounds of Tobacco and is willing that Judgment
 should be entered for the same and Cost thereon accruing. Therefore it is
 considered by the Court here viz. this Twentieth day of March Anno Domini
 One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen That the said ptt Francis
 Collins recover against the said Deft Francis Scott as well the said sume
 of five hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages on account of the said ptt and
 performing his promise and assumption as aforesaid and also the sume of Three
 hundred fifty seven pounds of Tobacco Cost by the said ptt about his site in
 this behalfe expended and by the Court here of his assent adjudged and the
 said Deft in mercy

John Moll — Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the
 William Powell — Twenty third day of November in the second year of his
 Lord ship's Dominion &c. That he take William Powell
 late of Kent County planter if he should be found in his
 Brilywick and him safe keep so that he have his body before his said Lord
 High Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chertsey
 in said County to answer unto John Moll of a plea of trespass on the Case and
 that he have then and there the said writ &c. Altho' which said next Court being
 the eighteenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day of return
 of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of said County and made
 return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as follows *Sci Corpus* & Simon
 Wilmer Sher And a Doeb being filed when said writ issued forth and
 a Copy thereof served therewith according to Act of assembly in such
 case made laws as follows viz. Maryland Kent County & William Powell late
 of Kent County planter was attached to answer unto John Moll of a plea of
 Tres.
