After which William Browne of said County here in Court cometh and acknowledges himselfe as Special Bail in the afd Court and doth undertake for the afd Debt the payment of the Debt afd and Cost thereon accruing if the Debt should be cast in the same And the Contumacious should not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the afd William Browne the Body of the afd Debt shall not render &c.

And the afd Debt by John Johnson his atty appeared to the above Court a Debt being filed in the same Court as was continued untill next Court.
