And a Declaration being filed when said writ issued forth and  
a Copy thereof served thereunto according to Act of Assembly in  
such Case made was as folo viz. Kent County B. Henry Chancell of Kent  
County Plaintiff ad. Deo Henry Chano was summoned to answer unto  
James Heath of a plea that he render him the Summe of Seven hundred  
and eighty seven pounds Tobacco of the Value of Seven hundred seven  
Shillings Sterling money which from him he unjustly detains &c.  
and whereupon the ap. ptt. by Thomas Bowne his atty Sach that  
whereas the ap. Deft. the sixteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord  
Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen at S. Pauls parish  
in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certant writing  
obligatory which he the said Deft. Sealed with his Seal and as the said  
delivered to the Court brought the date whereof is the same day and  
Year ap. bound himselfe to pay unto the ap. ptt. the ap. Summe of  
Seven hundred and eighty pounds Tobacco of the ap. Value of Seven  
hundred ten Shillings Sterling money being for the Rent of the thoro  
Dwelling plantation of the said Deft. due and ending the first day of  
November last past when thereunto required yet the ap. Deft. altho  
often required the ap. Summe of Seven hundred and eighty seven  
pounds of Tobacco to the said ptt. hath not paid but that to him to  
render or pay hitherto hath denied and still doth deny and unjustly  
detain to the Damage of him the said ptt. fifteen pounds Sterling money  
and therefore he brings Sute &c. *Brown v. Deft. ptt. in Doe's R. Soc.*
