he have his body before his Lordly Lordships Justices of the next Court to be  
held at our Court house in the Town of Chichester in Said County to answer  
unto James Heath of a plea that he render him the summe of seaven  
hundred and eighty pounds to be paid of the value of seaven hundred and  
fifty shillings Sterling money which from him he unjustly detains &c. And that  
he have then and there the said debt &c. paid which said next Court  
viz the nineteenth day of August the same year last mentioned the  
day of return of said debt came Simon Wilmer Gent High Sheriff of said  
County and made return thereof in those words thereon Endorsed as follows  
Viz. "Pepi Corpus pro S. Wilmer Sher"

AND a Declaration being made when said debt was paid forth and  
a copy thereof served therewith according to Act of Assembly 11.  
Such copy made was as follows viz Kent County by Henry Charlton of Kent  
County Master of the said Henry Chano was summoned to Answere unto  
James Heath of a plea that he render him the summe of seaven hundred  
and eighty seven pounds to be paid of the value of seaven pounds seven  
shillings Sterling money which from him he unjustly detains &c.  
And Whereupon the afof. by Thomas Browne his attly Saith that  
whereas the afof. Deth the sixteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord  
Christ one thousand seven hundred and Seventeen at St. Pauls Parish  
in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing —  
obligatory which he the said Deth sealed with his Seal and as afof. said  
delivered into Court brought the date whereof is the same day and  
year afof. bound himself to pay unto the afof. the afof. summe of —  
seven hundred and eighty pounds to be paid of the afof. value of seaven  
pounds term shillings Sterling money being for the Rent of the thre  
Dwelling plantation of the said Deth due and ending the first day of  
November last past when therunto required by the afof. Deth altho  
oftentimes required the afof. summe of seaven hundred and eighty seven  
pounds of tobacco to the said Deth hath not paid but that to him to  
render or pay hitherto hath denied and will doth deny and unjustly  
detain to the Damage of him the said Deth fifty four pounds Sterling money
