Court before the said Ed William Pearce and his associates then Justices of the  
said Late Lady the Queen of the Court & County of said upon the plea ass  
had Recovered against the ass Christopher Philipson as well the ass sum of  
thirty pounds Currant Silver money as ass Debt as also the sum of four  
hundred and forty five pounds of Tobacco Costs which to the said Jeddiah  
Andrews in the said Court here were adjudged for his damages which  
he had by Ovation of detaining of his debt whereof he is convicted sustain-  
ed as by the Record & process thereof in the same Court of the said Late Lady  
of Queen before the said Justices here Likewise residing doth manifestly  
appear yet the ass Christopher Philipson his body to the Custody of the Sheriff  
of said County did not deliver nor to the ass Jeddiah Andrews the debt and  
Costs satisfied as by the Information of the ass Jeddiah Andrews (we know  
ie. the Lord proprietarie received and we being willing that those things  
that in our ass Court before our ass Justices well Comanded you that by good &  
Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known to the ass Daniel Pearce &  
Thomas Cooke that they be and appear before the Justices of our next County  
Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on  
the third Tuesday in August next to show cause if any they have or know  
to say wherefore the ass Jeddiah Andrews will respect the ass thirty pounds  
the debt ass and the sum of four hundred and forty five pounds of Tobacco  
Damages appeared by them in forme ass Recognized of their Lands and Chattels  
to be made or the ass Christopher Philipson to render himselfe ought not  
according to the forme of the Recognition appeared if to them it shall seem  
Expedient and have you there the names of those by whom to them you  
make known and also this writ Writ of Habeas Corpus Thome Johnson Gent. chief
