of apela of trespass of the said Case and whereupon the afo^d by Thomas
Bonne his attly complains that whereas the afo^d Deft by the ninth day
of April in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred and
Sixteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction of this Court
in consideration that the afo^d at the special instance and request of the
afo^d Deft had then there sold and delivered unto the afo^d Deft and to the
proper use and behoofe of the afo^d Deft divers Goods and Merchandizes in one
also hercunto annexed set forth upon himselfe assumed and to the
said afo^d Then and there faithfully promised that he the said Deft so much Current
silver money of America as the afo^d Goods & Merchandizes sold and delivered as aforesaid at
the time of the sale and delivery thereof at reasonable rates and prises were worth and
amounted to unto the said afo^d Promised therunto required would to all and truly pay and content
and the afo^d did indeed pay that the afo^d Goods and Merchandizes sold and delivered as
afo^d at the time of the sale and delivery thereof at reasonable rates and prises were
worth and amounted unto the sume of two pounds twelve shillings and six pence Current
silver money of America in Manner as in the said afo^d Set forth or whiche the said
Deft then and there had Notice — And that whereas after the afo^d Deft afterwards viz the
Twenty third day of August in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred and
Seventeen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction of this Court aforesaid declared
that the afo^d at the like special instance and request of the afo^d Deft had then and there
last mentioned sold and delivered unto the afo^d Deft by the hands of a certain Captain Macdonald
and to the proper use and behoofe of the afo^d Deft Right bushell of Merchantable Wheat for
the sume of three hundred and twenty pounds of Merchantable Tobacco and four bushells
of Merchantable Indian Corn for the sume of two hundred pounds of Merchantable Tobacco
which in the whole amounts unto the sume of five hundred and twenty pounds of Merchantable
Tobacco upon himselfe assumed and to the said afo^d Then and there last mentioned faithfully promised that
he the said Deft the afo^d sume of five hundred and twenty pounds of Merchantable Tobacco unto
the said afo^d when therunto required would well and truly pay and content and that to whereas
