rever against the said Dft Abram Taylor as well the summe of eleven  
hundred and thirty two pounds of Tobacco Debts as also the sume of two hund-  
red eighty seven pounds of Tobacco lost by the afo<sup>d</sup> f<sup>t</sup> aboard his late ship that  
he hath expended and by the Court here of his afo<sup>d</sup> adjudged and the said Dft  
in mercy &

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the  
nineteenth day of June in the fourth year of His Lordships  
Dominion & that he take John Newsham late esq<sup>r</sup> of  
County in the province of Maryland planter abt John  
Newsham of the afo<sup>d</sup> County and province if he should be  
found in his Bailywick and him safe keep so that we have his body before us said  
Lord High Justices of the Peace for said County a la Court to be held for said County at  
the Court house in the town of Chichester in said County to answer unto John Johnson  
and Isabella his wife Adulcie of all Grievances the goods & Chattells Rights &  
Credits which were of Wm Blayde her late husband debt of aple that he render  
unto her the full sume of five thousand pounds of good merch. Tobacco w<sup>r</sup> from  
her he unjustly detains & and that he have then and there the said writ &  
at which said next Court Day the Nineteenth day of August the same year  
last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmergent Sheriff  
of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed  
followeth in Legi Corp<sup>s</sup> p<sup>r</sup> Simon Wilmergent Sheriff

AND the afo<sup>d</sup> Dft being called came and the afo<sup>d</sup> f<sup>t</sup> by Thomas Bowne their  
attorney prays that the afo<sup>d</sup> Dft may give special bail to the afo<sup>d</sup> election which  
was granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County who  
he shall give special bail

After which George Sanders of the afo<sup>d</sup> County comes into Court and  
acknowledges himself to be Special Bail in the afo<sup>d</sup> election and doth under-  
take for the afo<sup>d</sup> Dft the payment of the Debts and Loss thereon auring<sup>1</sup> if  
the afo<sup>d</sup> Dft shall be cast in the said and the Condemnation Shall not Satisfie  
nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the  
afo<sup>d</sup> George Sanders the Body of the said Dft shall not render it  
and it Deed which foloweth
