And now at this Court came the aff pet by Thomas Borone his attorney & prays that he may have Exemption of the aff goods and Chattells Rights and Credits of the aff Charles Johnson attached in the hands of the Several persons mentioned in the return of the aff writ of Attachment and the aff Thomas Ruggold Abraham Melton Thomas Jones Nathaniel Pearce William Thomas Samuel Clarke and Christopher Bateman the aff Several persons in whose hands the aff writ of Attachment was laid come not to show any cause why the aff goods and Chattells Rights and Credits should not be Exempted in their hands to the use of the aff James Smith Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz. this Twelfth day of November Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and eighteenth That the Goods and Chattells Rights & Credits of the aff Charles Johnson in the hands of the Several persons as followeth viz. Thomas Ruggold Thirty bushells of Salt of the value of thirty Shillings Current money in the hands of Abraham Melton one hundred and forty eight foot of plank of the value of Seven Shillings Current money and in the hands of Thomas Jones one old Shallop with Standing Rigen and Sables of the value of six pounds Current money and in the hands of Nathaniel Pearce Cunic Earthen muggs four quart Ditto three pint Ditto two Ditto Sawers five knives and forks one pair Gloves two Grose pipes and forty pound of powder) to the value of two pounds five Shillings and six pence Current money in the hands of William Thomas one pistol of the value one pound four Shillings Current money and in the hands of Christopher Bateman one old Sable of the value of fifteen Shillings Current money and in the hands of Samuel Clarke one black mare of the price of forty Shillings Current money which Several Sums in the aff Several persons hands amounts in the whole to the Summe of fourteen pounds five Shillings and six pence Current money That the aff Several Sums in the aff Several persons hands be Condemned to the use of the aff James Smith and that he have thereof Execution he the said James Smith give Security according to act of assembly in such case made & on which Simon Wilmer of said County comes into Court and acknowledges himself Security for the aff James Smith that if in case the aff Charles Johnson either by himself or his attorney shall within a year and a day from issuing out the aff writ of Attachment come into Court and appear to the original return and make it appear that the demand in the aff Attachment is satisfied or any part thereof that then the aff pett shall make restitution of the same or that the aff Simon Wilmer will do it for him or the value thereof
