 Complaini for that whereas the ap Deft viz. the Twenty second day of August
 in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and Seven to wit
 at S. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court had
 accounted with the ap ptt. of and Concerning Divers Sums of Money to
 the same ptt. by the ap Deft before that time owing and unpaid and
 upon that accounting he the said Deft then and there was found in
 arrearage to the said ptt. in the Sum of three pounds Seven Shillings
 and Eleven pence Current Silver money of Maryland and so being
 found in arrearage the ap Deft in Consideration thereof afterwards viz. the ap
 Twenty second day of August in the year ap at the parish County Jurisdiction ap upon
 himself assumed and to the said ptt. then and there last mentioned faithfully promised
 that he the said Deft the ap Sum of three pounds Seven Shillings and Eleven
 pence Current Silver Money of Maryland to the said ptt. when thereunto
 required would well and truly pay & Content and that whereas also the
 ap Deft afterwards viz. the ap Twenty second day of August in the year
 ap at the parish County and Jurisdiction ap was indebted unto the said ptt.
 in the Sum of three pounds Seven Shillings and Eleven pence for the like
 Sum of Money by the ap Deft to wit before of ap ptt. before that time had
 and so thereof being indebted the ap Deft in Consideration thereof afterwards
 viz. the ap Twenty second day of August in the year ap at the parish County
 and Jurisdiction ap upon himself assumed & to the said ptt. then and there
 last mentioned faithfully promised that he the said Deft. the ap Sum of three
 pounds Seven Shillings and Eleven pence Current Silver money of Maryland to
 the said ptt. when thereunto required would well and truly pay & Content
 Nevertheless the ap Deft his several promises & assumptions ap in forme
 ap made little minding but plotting & fraudulently intending him the
 ptt. in that behalfe Craftily & Subtly to deceive and defraud the ap several
 Sums of money in the whole amounting unto the Sum of six pounds
 fifteen Shill. and ten pence Current ^{silver} money of Maryland to the said ptt.
 altho afterwards viz. the Twenty second day of September in the year ap &
