Seventh day of May in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven
 Hundred and nine at S. Pauls parish in Kent County within the juris-
 diction of this Court was accounted with the said Edward Chetham in his
 life time of divers Sums of money to the said Edward Chetham in his
 life time by the said Edward Warner then and there owing and
 unpaid and upon that Accounting the said Edward Warner then and
 there in the life time of the said Edward Chetham was found in
 arrears towards the said Edward Chetham in the Sum of two
 pounds five Shillings and Six pence Sterling money the said Edward
 Warner in Consideration hereof afterwards by the Seventh day of
 May in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven Hundred and
 nine at S. Pauls parish in Kent County within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court in the life time of the said Edward Chetham upon
 himself assumed and to the said Edward Chetham then and there last
 mentioned faithfully promised that he the said Edward Warner the
 said two pounds five Shillings and Six pence Sterling money to the said
 Edward Chetham when thereto required would well and truly pay and
 Content Never the less the said Edward Warner his promise and
 assumption as in form of made little minding but fraudulently
 intending to deceive and defraud the said two pounds five Shillings
 and Six pence Sterling money or any part thereof to the said Edward
 Chetham in his life time or after the death of the said Edward Chetham
 to the said Mary and Henry while the said Mary was Sole or to the said
 James and Mary and Henry or either of them after Esponsals Cele-
 brated between the said James and Mary or to the said James and Mary
 or either of them after the death of the said Henry hath not paid or
 to either or any of them for the same made Content all the that to do
 the said Edward Warner afterwards by the tenth day of January in the
 Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven Hundred and Nine and after
 after at S. Pauls parish in Kent County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court
 by the said Edward Chetham in his life time and after the said Edward Chetham
 death by the said Mary and Henry while the said Mary was Sole and since the
 death of the said Henry and the Esponsals as by the said James and Mary the
 Eighth day of July in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven Hundred and
 Nineteen at S. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was
 thereto required but that to the said Edward Chetham in his life time or after
 the death of the said Edward Chetham to the said Mary and Henry while she was Sole
 and after the Esponsals as to the said James and Mary and Henry or either of them in
 the life time of the said Henry and to the said James and Mary since the death of
 the said Henry hath not paid or to the said James and Mary since the death of
 pay yet doth deny to the damage of them the said James and Mary four pounds Ten
 Shillings Sterling money and in delay of the Execution of the Testament
 and thereupon they bring Sute and bring her into Court the
 Letters Testamentary of the said Edward Chetham by which it will
 appear
