Chattels Rights and Credits of the said Edward Warner: Therefore it
is considered by the Court here viz. this Twenty first day of November
Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen That the
said p[ar]ties James Heath and Mary his wife Executrix as afove have
an Attachment against the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of
the said Edward Warner for the said Summe of two pounds five Shillings
and six pence Sterling and also the Summe of Three hundred Eighty
three pounds of Tobacco Cost by the said p[ar]ties about their Sute in this
behalf expended and by the Court here of their assent adjudged &c.

William Glanville Commanded it was to the Sheriff of
Donn Kerslagh Kent County the twenty second day of August in
the fourth Year of his Lord Shipp's Dominion that
he take Dominick Kerslagh late of Kent
County Prisoner if he should be found in your
County and him safe keep so that he have his Body before his Lord
Shipp's Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court House in the Town of
Chester in said County to answer unto William Glanville of a plea of
Trespas of the safe and that he have then and there the said writ &c.

All which said next Court viz. the eighteenth day of November the
same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer
Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words to wit
undered as follows viz. *Copi Corpus* Simon Wilmer Sheriff

And now at this Court viz. the same day last mentioned the said Deft
being called came and the said p[ar]ty by Michael Howard his atty prays
that the said Deft may give Special Bail to the said Action which is
granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County
until he should give Special bail as afove

After which *Benev. Blackiston* of said County here in Court cometh &
acknowledged himself as Special bail in the said Action and doth under
take for the said Deft the payment of the damages in the said Action and
Cost thereon accruing if the said p[ar]ty should obtain Judgment in the same
and the said Deft's condemnation should not satisfy nor himself to the
Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver so that the said *Benev.*
Blackiston the body of the said Deft should not render
