just & full sum of thirty pounds current money of y^e province aforesd
which to him he oweth and from him he unjustly detains &c. And that he
have then and there the said writ &c.

Year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer
Gent. High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words.
thereon Endorsed as folo viz. Epi Corpus & Simon Wilmer Sheriff
All W^{ch} a Declaration being filed when said writ was forth and a copy
thereof served therewith according to an act of assembly in such case made
which is as folo viz. Kent County Thomas Garnett of Kent County Tanner
otherwise called Tho. Garnett of new garden in Pennsylvania was summoned to
answer unto John Woodall administrator of all and singular the goods &
Chattells Rights & Credits which were of Edward Maister late of Kent County
in Maryland deceased of a plea that he render unto him the just & full
sum of thirty pounds current money of y^e province aforesd which to him
he oweth and from him he unjustly detains &c. and whereupon the app^d John
David Macbode his atty. said that whereas the app^d Thomas on the fourteenth
day of February in y^e Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and
sixteen at Paul's Parish in Kent County and within the jurisdiction of this
Court by his certain bill obligatory which he the said Thomas sealed with
his Seal and as his deed delivered hereto Court brought whose date is the
same day and Year app^d granted himself to be owing and justly indebted
unto Edward Maister app^d in y^e just & full sum of sixteen pounds current
money of y^e province app^d to be paid to the said Edward Maister or his heirs
or assigns or Lawfull attorney at or before the tenth day of May in the Year
of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighteen and yet the
app^d Thomas altho often demanded the app^d sum of sixteen pounds current
money of y^e province app^d to the app^d Edward in his lifetime or to the app^d
John after his the said Edward's death to which the said John administra-

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
