 Nichol Waterman of Kent County planter
 otherwise called Nicholas Waterman of said County late in the Court of our said King George here that is to say the fiftenth day of November Anno dⁿⁱ 1718 before James Harris Esquire Justice of our said Lord the King of his said Court for the said County of Kent here that is to say at a Court in the Court house in the town of Chester in said County spent in the said Court in his proper person assumed upon himselfe that if it should happen that a certain John Cochran of Kent County planter should be cast or judgment against the said John Cochran should be given all the Sute of a certain Penatus Smith by of name of Penatus Smith of Queen Anns County Gent in a plea of Debt of five hundred pounds of good sound Merchants like Tobacco then in the said Court before the said Justice depending that the ap^{pl} Nicholas Waterman did undertake for the said John Cochran the payment of the Debt & Cost if it should happen that the said Penatus Smith should obtain judgment against the said John Cochran in the said plea of Debt and that the said John Cochran the Condemnation should not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the said Nicholas Waterman the body of the said John Cochran should not render to which certain Summe the ap^{pl} Nicholas Waterman acknowledged of his Lands and Chattells to be made and to the behoove & use of the said Penatus Smith to be levied if it should happen the said John Cochran in any the premises to make default and thereof in Lawfull manner to be convicted as by the Record and process thereof in the said Court of the said Lord the King here residing manifestly appeareth and altho the ap^{pl} Penatus Smith afterwards viz on the same day last mentioned in the said County Court before the said James Harris Gent
 and
