Gaunter all due John Gilbert if he should be found in his Bailly-wick and him safe keep so that he have his body before his said Lord Shipp Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto John March a plea that he render to him the full sume of four hundred Twenty four pounds of good Sound Tobacco (cur of ground leaves and stalk and Casque to containe the same of the value of five pound Sterling money which he unjustly detains &c. And that he have them and there the said writ &c. All which said writ was the eighteenth day of November the same year last mentioned the way of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent.
