Emmanuel Hurst Entered into Recognition to the sume of ten pounds
 Sterling for the appearance of the afo Jane Macneale as afo This Court here
 discharges the same Recognition

Ordered by the Court here that the afo Jane Macneale be in the Sheriffs
 custody untill she find Suretys for her appearance to next Court and to
 answer unto such things as shall be objected ag^t her on his Lord
 Ships Behalf & to be of good Behaviour in the mean time

Jane Macneale afo comes into Court and acknowledge herself Indebted
 to his Lordships his heires and Successors in the sume of Twenty pounds
 Sterling to be Levyed on her goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements
 Conditionally that if she do not make her personal appearance at the
 next Court and to answer unto all such things as shall be objected against
 her on his Lordships Behalf and in the mean time she is to be of good
 Behaviour wherewith she Acknowledges herself for bound

Likewise came into Court Francis Mooths and Roger Hix both of
 said County and acknowledged themselves indebted to his Lordship his
 heires and Successors in the sume of ten pounds Sterling each to be
 Levyed on their goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements Conditionally
 that if the afo Jane Macneale shall not make her personal appearance
 at the next Court to be held for said County and that she is to answer
 as afo and in the mean time she is to be of good Behaviour wherewith
 they acknowledge themselves content

 Recognition for her appearance to next Court as an Evidence ag^t
 the afo Jane Macneale

Mary Clarke afo Acknowledges her self indebted to his Lordship
 his heires and Successors in the sume of five pounds Sterling to be
 Levyed on his goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements Conditionally
 that if she do not make her personal appearance at the next Court and
 then & there to give Evidence on his Lordships Behalf against the afo
 Jane Macneale wherewith she acknowledge her self content
