ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Mary Clarke enter into Recognizance as an Evidence against the aforesaid Peter

Mary Clarke as aforesaid acknowledges herself indebted to his Lord Ship his heirs and Successors in the Sum of five pounds Sterling to be Levied on her goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if she or the aforesaid Mary shall not appear at the next Court to be held for said County and then and there to give Evidence on his Lord Ship's behalf against the aforesaid Peter Morcy wherewith she acknowledges herself Content

Rebeckah Rye having taken a Child by the Request of one of his said Lord Ship's Justices of the peace for said County that was born to a certain Mary Hussey dec. and the Court agrees with the aforesaid Rebeckah to give her one hundred pounds of Tobacco p month for the time she hath had the same and untill June Court next and the same to be allowed in the Levy to which the aforesaid Rebeckah consents
