Under the preceding Bill of Indictment was as follow viz. Anna Bora Edward
Davis Foreman

and the afo Ann Kurnard in her proper person appeared to the afo Indictm.
and the same being read asab the Court that she cannot gainsay but
that she is guilty as afo and Submits to the Court on the Same Therefore it
is Considered by the Court here by this Nineteenth day of March Annoque
Domini one thousand Seven hundred and eighteen that the afo Anna
Kurnard pay the sume of Thirty Shillings Current money her fine for
Committing the offence of fornication afo according to Law and also pay the
sume of one hundred and eighty two pounds of Tobacco few curring on the
premises afo

Ordered by the Court here that the afo Anna Kurnard prove the persons
that committed the fornication afo with her the afo Anna being sworn on
the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God saith that William Debruler was the
person that did begin the Case born Child the last bore for which she stands
Indicted afo

ordered by the Court here that there be allowed to the person where she was
delivered the sume of four hundred pounds of tobacco for trouble and charge to
for bringing the afo Child to bed and in looking after her the time she
lay fme by the afo Anna Kurnard and William Debruler

On which William Debruler of said County was called who came and in
his proper person appeared in Court And it is ordered by the Court here
that the afo William as reputative father of the afo Child enter into Recog-
nition with good Suretyes in the sume of forty pounds of tobacco monthly while the
Child may be burthenome to the County for the maintenance of the same
William Debruler afo comes into Court and acknowledge himself Indebted
to the afo Child in the sume of forty pounds of Tobacco to
be paid to her every Month She keeps and maintains the afo Child until
the afo Child may be no further burthenome to the County wherewith he
acknowledges himself Content

Benjamin Blaxkledge and Daniel Perkins both of this County acknow-
ledge themselves Indebted to the afo Anna Kurnard in the sume of twenty-
pounds of Tobacco each month to be paid to her every month She keeps
and maintains the afo Child until the afo Child may be no further burthenome
to the County if the afo William Debruler do not pay it him self where-
with they acknowledge themselves to be therewith Content.

Ordered by the Court here that the afo William Debruler enter into
Recognaunce for his agreement to pay her with Suretyes

William Debruler appears into Court and Acknowledges himself Indebted
to his Bro. Hugh his heire and Successor in the sume of Ten pounds per a.
68
