horses and Pences or in the summe of Two pounds Sterl each to be Seized on their goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the selfe William Lebruler shall not appear at the next County Court to be held for said County and to Answer as aforesaid that in the mean time he is to be of good Behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves to be Content.
