Proclamation a^o Dock called over a sold by William Glenville Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Kent County greeting

John Frew — Wee Command you that you take the body of John Frew of Kent County planter if he shall be found in your Bailiwick and him safe keep to the day we have this body before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March next to satisfy unto William Glenville of said County sumbolde p^{ts} as well the summe of one pound eight Shillings Currant money and five hundred and sixe pounds of Tobacco Damages by the said p^{ts} recovered against the said deft before the Justices of our said Court on the eighteenth day of June last wherof he is Convent as appears upon Record as also the summe of eight hundred and forty nine pounds of tob^o and one half p^o of Tobacco Cost of Rate as also together with the summe of forty sixe pounds of tob^o additionall but hereof faile not at your perill and hazard then and there this writ of Writ^{ts} Nathaniel Symon Gent. chiefe Justice of our said Court this Twentieth day of November in the fourth Year of our Dominion *Wm Dand 1718* *Chas. Smith*

At which said next Court viz. the Seventeenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. Justice of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon directed as folo^o viz. *Expi Corpus p^o Simon Wilmer Sheriff*
