In the said following Security as the Law directs upon which James Smith of said County here in Court acknowledges himself as Surety for the said John March that is to say if the said John March shall within a year and day from granting the said writ of Attachment by himself or his atty come and appear to the original Citon and make it appear that the Demand of the said John March is satisfied or any part thereof shall discompt that then the said John March shall make restitution of the said twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco or the value thereof
