 detains. And that he have them and there the said writ is
 all which said writ is by the Seventeenth day of March the
 same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon
 Wilmer Esq^r High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in
 those words therein endorsed as folo by Esq^r Corwin & Wilmer the
 and a Declaration being filed when said writ placed forth and copy
 thereof served there with according to Act of a Assembly in such Case made
 was as folo by. In County of George Sanders of Kent County in the
 Province of Maryland Planter. and did George Sanders of Kent County
 Planter was summoned to Answer unto Richard Bennett of a plea
 that he render to him of sum of Eleven thousand six hundred & two
 pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco Clear from all Spotted
 mouldered trash or ground leaves in Cask of the value of forty nine
 pounds Sterling money which he unjustly detains. And when upon
 the 17th day of March last by Thomas Boone his attorney sent that whereas the app
 Deft the thirtieth day of July in the Year of our Lord Christ Seventeen
 hundred and nine at St Pauls Parish in Kent County as within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court by his Honor's bill obligatory which the said Deft
 sealed with his Seal and as he did delivered hereinto Court brought the
 date whereof is the same day and year as bound and obliged himself &
 his heirs Executors & Dom in the app sum of Eleven thousand six hundred
 & two pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco Clear from all Spotted
 Mouldered trash or ground leaves in Cask of the app value of forty nine
 pounds Sterling money for the true payment of the full and just sum of
 five thousand eight hundred and one pounds of like Tobacco Duplicated
 as app and cash to contain of sume to the app p^t his Ex^{or} adm^r or
 assigns upon the tenth day of June next ensuing the date of the said
 bill payment on the said Deft then dwelling plantation and the
 said p^t in deed sent that the app Deft hath not paid to the app p^t
 the app five thousand eight hundred & one pounds of Tobacco upon
 the app tenth day of June which to him (at or) upon the same day he
 ought to have paid according to the forms and Effect of the
 Bill
