Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore, do to the Sheriff of Kent County greeting well Command you that you take the body of George Sanders if he shall be found in your Bailwaik & him safe keep so that you have his body before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March next to satisfy unto William Frisby as well the Sum of twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco which was Condemned in the hands of the afo George Sanders as the Rights and Credits of a certain John Moore of Kent County Weaver and Bidm Moore of said County were before the Justices of our said Court on the Twentieth day of March Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Seventeen whereof the afo George Sanders was Condemned as appears upon Record as also forty six pounds of Tobacco left arising on this precept hereof made not at your peril and have you then and there this writ W<sup>m</sup> Frisby Nathaniel Hyman Gent Chief Justice of our said Court this Twentieth day of November in the fourth year of his Lord Ships Dominion &c Anno Domini 1719

At which Court on the seventeenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent High Sheriff of Kent County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as follows

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the Twentieth day of November in the fourth year of his Lord Ships Dominion &c That he take Walter King of Kent County Pastor if he should be found in his Bailwaik and him safe keep so that he have his body before his Lord Ships Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto William Frisby late Sheriff of Kent County of plea of trespass upon the Case and that he have then and there the said writ left return said next Court viz the seventeenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as follows  
Cepi Corpus Simon Wilmer Sheriff  
and now at the said Court the afo Deft being called and the afo ptt by Thomas Boorne his atty pray that the said Deft might give Special bail to the afo ptt which was granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall give Special bail as afo after which John Wood and William Ellett both of said County were in Court cometh and they jointly and severally acknowledge themselves Special bail in the afo ptt and they and either of them do undertake the payment of the Damages in the afo ptt and Cost thereon accruing if it shall
