Donslagh } Glenville of a plea of trespass of the life
and to recover the said William by Michael
Howard his atty complements that whereas the said

William on the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and fourteen at Pauls parish within the
Jurisdiction of this Court at the special Justice and request of the said Dominick
and to the proper use and behoofe of the said Dominick sold and delivered to
the said Dominick the several quantities of Rum Cyder beer dyall & Lodging
and other suitable ordinary accommodations in an Cuo. horeunto annexed
specifically set forth at the several rates and prices in the said Cuo.
mentioned in the whole amounting unto the sum of four hundred and
twenty pounds of merchantable Tobacco in consideration whereof the said Dominick
then and there last mentioned upon himself assumed unto the same
William faithfully promised that he the said Dominick the said sum of
four hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid unto the said William
when thereunto required would well and truly pay and content and the said
William indeed sayth that the rum Cyder beer dyall & Lodging & other
ordinary accommodations sold and delivered as aforesaid at the time of the sale and
delivery thereof at reasonable rates and prices were worth and amounted to
the sum of four hundred & twenty pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid in manner
as in the said Cuo. set forth of which the said Dominick then and there
last mentioned had notice never the less the said Dominick his promise
and assumption of nothing regarding but threatening and fraudulently
intending sum the said William in this behalf craftily and subtilly to deceive
and defraud the said four hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid or any
part thereof according to his promise and assumption of unto the same
William as yet hath not paid nor in any sort made content altho' so do.
The same the said Dominick on the tenth day of April in the year of our
Lord seventeen hundred and fifteen at the parish County and Jurisdiction aforesaid
and often afterwards by the said William he was thereunto required but
the same unto him the said William hitherto hath denied and still doth
deny and unjustly detain to the Damage of him the said William eight
hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid and therefore he brings
