&c. and whereupon the app^t p^t Mathias by Thomas Boone his atty sent
that whereas the app^t p^t the fifteenth day of August in the year of our
Lord Christ seventeen hundred and thirteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent
County within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory
which the said John sealed with his seal and as his deed delivered hereto
Court brought the date whereof is the same day and year aforesaid acknowledged and
granted himself to owe and be indebted to the app^t James in his lifetime in the just
sum of one thousand four hundred pounds of good sound leaf Tobacco clear of all trash
in cash to contain the same to be paid to the said James his Ex^{or} or Adm^r upon the then
dwelling plantation of the said John when thereunto required and for the true pay-
ment thereof the said John then and there firmly by the said bill obliged & bound himself in
