up p<sup>t</sup> Convoyment in the said County at or upon the tenth day of March next Insuring the date of the said Bill and the ap<sup>t</sup> p<sup>t</sup> in deed saith that the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft<sup>r</sup> hath not paid to the ap<sup>t</sup> p<sup>t</sup> the ap<sup>t</sup> sume of one thousand and ninety three pounds of Tobacco at or upon the ap<sup>t</sup> tenth day of March which to him at or upon the same day he ought to have done according to the forme and effect of the same Bill by which Election hath accrued to the ap<sup>t</sup> p<sup>t</sup> to rec<sup>d</sup> and have of the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft<sup>r</sup> the ap<sup>t</sup> sume of two thousand one hundred and Eighty Six pounds of Tobacco if at the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft<sup>r</sup> altho often required the ap<sup>t</sup> sume of two thousand one hundred and Eighty Six pounds of Tobacco to the said p<sup>t</sup> hath not paid but that to him to Render or pay hath altogether denied and still doth deny and unjustly detaine to the damage of the ap<sup>t</sup> p<sup>t</sup> forty three pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup> money and thereupon he bringeth this

Whereupon at the prayer of the p<sup>t</sup> by his atty<sup>y</sup> of Deft<sup>r</sup> is adjudged to give Special Bail in y<sup>e</sup> Union ap<sup>d</sup> And that the Justices of said County keepy<sup>e</sup> the Deft<sup>r</sup> in Custody until he shall give Special Bail as ap<sup>d</sup>

And the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft<sup>r</sup> in his proper person comes and defends the force and injury which he doth and says that he cannot gain say the p<sup>t</sup> his action ap<sup>d</sup> so as ap<sup>d</sup> him brought nor can he say but that the said p<sup>t</sup> ought to recover his debt ap<sup>d</sup> and costs of suite against him which the said p<sup>t</sup> does not gain say therefore it is considered by the Justices here the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June Anno Dom<sup>o</sup> 1719 that the said Gilbert Salomon recover against the said George Gleaves sum<sup>m</sup> as well the sume of two thousand one hundred and Eighty Six pounds of Tobacco his debt ap<sup>d</sup> in forme ap<sup>d</sup> Insured as ap<sup>d</sup> the sume of Three hundred and Sixty Six pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged to him for his costs and Charges by him labored his suite in this behalf laid out and expended and the Deft<sup>r</sup> in morey &c.

Whereupon James Roe of said County Jurorholder present in Court undertakes for the ap<sup>t</sup> George Gleaves sum<sup>m</sup> the payment of the Convoyment in the Judgment ap<sup>d</sup> or that the said George Gleaves sum<sup>m</sup> be body to the Custody of the Justices of said County in satisfaction thereof And render of that the said James Roe will do it for him
