The app George Morey in his proper person here present in Court acknowledges himself indebted to his Lordship his heirs and Assignors in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he does not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for the said County and then and there to answer unto a Certain Indictment ag him in this Court for committing fornication with a Certain Mary Holager and in the mean time to be of good behaviour whereunto he acknowledges himself content

Whereas Thomas Dinn Sen and William Debruder both of said County Planters here present in Court acknowledges themselves indebted to his Lordship his heirs and Assignors in the sum of five pounds Sterling each
