His Lord Ship Kent County & The Jurors for the Hon. the Lord Prop. and the body of Kent County on their oath do present that Philip Jones late of Langfords Bay upper hundred in the said County the sixteenth day of June in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand Seven hundred and Nineteen at Langfords Bay upper hundred in the said County & within the Jurisdiction of this Court hath frequently learned to Common Labour at the rate or price a Certain orphan boy called John Hearn bound to him the said Philip Jones before the said time by the said County Court to learn the trade of a Taylor neglecting to teach the said orphan his trade of a Taylor aforesaid to the great abuse of the said orphan and against the peace of our said Lord Prop. his title and dignity and against the form of an Act of Assembly of this Province now in force in such Case made & provided

On the back of the preceding bill was Endorsed as follows by Nilla Vere & Francis Barney Foreman

and the said Philip in his proper person appears to the said Lord and says that he cannot gain say but that he hath put the said Orphan to the use & use instead of his learning the trade aforesaid and submits to the Court on the same Therefore it is considered by the Justices here this 18 day of June Anno Dom 1719 That the said Philip Jones for the offence aforesaid is condemned to pay and satisfy to the said John Hearn the sum of two hundred pounds of Tobacco and also the sum of £12 hundred sixty two pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged & arising on the premises aforesaid in the officers of this Court
