The ap Sarah in her proper person ap. to the same on which the
Judgm. ap being endorsed as ap. More but is adjudged not good and
sufficient in law; Therefore it is considered by the Court here by
this 18th day of June Anno Dom 1719. That for the fault of the Judge
of the said Judgm. The ap Sarah Nicholas be therefrom acquit but
that she pay the fees arising on the same amounting to the sum of
two hundred forty five pounds of Tobacco
ordered by the Court that she be immediately until she satisfy the
fees on the premises ap.

John Glappi of the ap County planter in Court here present undertakes
for the ap Sarah Nicholas the payment of the fees on the premises ap and
the ap Sarah is therefrom acquit

His Lordship Judgement for feloniously taking one hundred
pounds Tobacco the goods of a certain Richard Davis
to whom he ap. and with him is not guilty and for
Joseph Wright that he put himself on God & the Country
Ordered to Ful. into Exiguit. with Sureties for his
appearance to next Court to answer to.
Joseph Wright ap. here present in Court acknowledges himself indebted
to his Lordship his heirs and Successors in the sum of Twenty pounds
Sterling to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements
Conditionally that if does not make his personal appearance at the
next Court to be held for said County and to answer unto a certain Judgment
against him for feloniously taking one hundred pounds of Tobacco the
goods & Chattels of a certain Richard Davis of the County and that in
the mean time he is to be of good behaviour wherewith he acknowledges
himself content

Francis Meeks and Thomas Wini Sen. acknowledges themselves
indebted to his Lordship his heirs & Successors in the sum of Ten
pounds Sterling each to be levied on their goods and Chattels Lands
and Tenements Conditionally that if the ap Joseph Wright does not appear
and answer as ap and that in the mean time he is to be of good
behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves to be therewith
