 his attly Complaineth that whereas the said George Sanders on the Twenty
 fifth day of November in the Year of our Lord God one Thousand Seven
 hundred and Seventeen at Paul parish in the County afo within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory which the same
 Daniel with the Seal of the said George Sanders sent here into Court brings
 whose date is the same day and Year afo bound himself his heirs Executors
 and Administrators in the afo sum of four hundred ninety and four pounds
 of Tobacco in Cash of the said value of five pounds Sterling money to be
 paid unto the said Daniel Delahante his heirs Executors Administrators
 or assigns convenient in the said County afo upon the tenth day of
 December then next ensuing the date of the said Bill obligatory and the
 said Daniel in fact saith that the said George Sanders hath not paid unto
 the same Daniel the afo four hundred and ninety four pounds of Tobacco
 in Cash of the afo value at or upon the said tenth day of December
 which to him he ought to pay at or upon the said tenth day of Dec
 according to the form and Effect of the said Bill obligatory by which
 action hath accrued unto the same Daniel to Recover and have from
 the said George the afo four hundred and ninety four pounds of Tobacco
 and Cash of the afo value of five pounds Nevertheless the said George
 Sanders although required the afo four hundred and ninety four
 pounds of Tobacco and Cash of the afo value unto the same Daniel as
 yet hath not paid but the same to him to pay hitherto hath refused
 and still doth refuse and unjustly detaineth wherefore the said Daniel
 saith that he is the worse and hath damage ten hundred pounds
 of Tobacco of the value of Ten pounds Sterling money and therefore
 brings Suit &c.
