 Thomas Mahone Six days Ordered by the Court here that the sd Thomas Jor pay unto
 the said Thomas Cording for his attendance as aff the Summe of one hundred and
 Eighty pounds of Tobacco

Peter Cording proves he attended this Court on End for Thomas Jor against Thomas
 Mahone Six days Ordered by the Justice here that the said Thomas Jor pay unto
