On the oath of the preceding and was answered by this 17 day of March 1719 the within named Thomas Gray upon the Holy Oath of almighty God that the within acct. is just and true as it stands corrected and that he hath not received any part or parcel thereof more than given Credit for Before me one of his Lordships Justices of the province of Maryland

And the said Wm. Smith that by any thing prealleged from having his action off he ought not to be barred nor the said Debt to have his discount because he saith that the aforementioned Thomas hath not an account of his own amounting unto two pounds Eleven Shillings and Six pence or any part thereof which hath or should be due to the said Thomas since he hath passed the said Bill as a Act made as the said Thomas hath above by pleading alleged and this he prays may be inquired of by the Country

And the Debt in like manner
Whereupon Command is given to the Sheriff of said County that he immediately cause to come here Justice Esq. who next the 15th of August 1719 because as well the said Thomas hath received the said Debt now here at this day viz the 19th day of June Anno Domini 1719 makes return that he hath here ready to receive the said Debt by his receipt he was Commanded and now here afterwards viz the day and year last mentioned comes again as well the said Debt by his atty app as the said Debt by his atty app and the Jurors of that Jury being impanelled who being called likewise came to wit Thomas Christian George Ayers Thomas Hebron Mich.
