After tenth day of August to wit the tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and nineteen it was by the said Court the sum to be paid by the said Debtor to the Plaintiff and his Justices to the damage of the said Plaintiff two hundred pounds Sterling money and thereupon he the Plaintiff

Motioned and it is John Doe Right Rose

Whereupon at the prayer of the Plaintiff by majority the Court doth adjudge to give speciall Bailie to the Plaintiff and that the Sheriff of said County keep the said Debtor in safe Custody until he shall give Speciall cause whereupon Owen Magrave of Kent County planter present here in Court undertake for the said Robert Brown that in case the said Philip Kennard shall Recover judgment in the plebe against the said Robert Browne or that he the said Robert Browne shall be therein Convinced that then he the said Robert Browne shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County in Satisfaction thereof or that the said Owen Magrave will do it for him

And now at this Court to wit the 19 day of August anno Domini 1719 here present cometh defendant the fore named in injury whom Mr. A. M. says — that he cannot gainsay the first action aforesaid brought against him brought nor can he say but that the said Plaintiff ought to Recover his debt by payment of the premises aforesaid to the summe of Six hundred and five pounds of Tobacco and Cost of Suite against him which the said Plaintiff does not gainsay Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August anno Domini 1719 aforesaid his debt before informed aforesaid Composed at also the summe of Two hundred Eighty Five pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged to him for his Costs and Charges by him late incurred in this Cause and sued and expended and the Debt in money due
