Now at this Court to wit the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Dom 1719 here present the a<sup>d</sup> Deft in proper person comes and defends the force and injury whereof. And says that he cannot gainsay the p<sup>l</sup>t. his action a<sup>d</sup> so as a<sup>d</sup> against him brought nor can he say but that the said p<sup>l</sup>t ought to recover his ~~debt~~ by occasion of the premises a<sup>d</sup> to the sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco and two Barrells of Indian Corne which the said p<sup>l</sup>t does not gainsay Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Dom 1719 a<sup>d</sup> that the said Owen Magrath recover against the said Thomas Hart. as well the sume of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco as also two barrells of Indian Corne his Debt a<sup>d</sup> in forme a<sup>d</sup> Confessed as also the sume of Two hundred and Ninety pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged to him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Sale in this behalfe paid out and expended and the Deft. in mercy &c.

 and Nineteen at Langfords Bay Lower hundred in the County a<sup>d</sup> and  
 within the Jurisdiction of this Court the fear of God before her eyes not  
 having but by the instigation of the Devil being led, did Commit  
 fornication with a certain person to the Jurors unknown and thereby  
 did suffer herself to be bogott with Child to the high displeasure of  
 Almighty God and the evil and pernicious example of others against  
 the peace of our said Lord Proprietarie his rule and dignity and against  
 the form of an Act of asembly of this Province now in force in such  
 Case made and provided &c.
