Ordered by the Court here that the app Joseph Wright enter into recognizance with Sureties for his appearance to the next Court Joseph Wright app comes into Court and acknowledges himself indebted to his Lord Ship his heirs and Successors in the Summe of Twenty pound Sterling to be levied on his goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if he do not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County and that he an swor unto a certain Judgment found against for Stealing too. belonging to A Certain Richard Davis and in the meantime to be of good behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself Content

Thomas Wynn Sen. and John Ellwicks acknowledged themselves indebted to his Lord Ship his heirs and Successors in the Summe of Ten pounds Sterl each to be levied on their goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if the app Joseph Wright shall not appear and answer as app and in the meantime he was to be of good behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves Content

His Lord Ship The app William Morris entered into Recognizance in the Summe of twenty pound Sterling to the use of his Lord Ship the twenty sixth day of May Anno Dom 1719 for his appearance to the then next Court to be holden for said County before M^r William Comogys one of his Lord Shipp's Justices of the peace for said County and at the said County Court he was to a Oide the Judgment of the said Court. But the app William Morris at the then next Court being the 16th day of June Anno Dom 1719 did not appear according to the Tenour of his Recognizance app And now at this Court to wit the 17th day of August Anno Dom 1719 the app William Morris being solemnly called to make his appearance to his app Recognizance whereby he might save himself and his Baile being M^r Gideon Pearce who at the same time app being the twenty sixth day of May Anno Dom 1719 entered into Recognizance in the Summe of Ten pounds Sterl to the use of the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietor conditionally that if the said William Morris did not make his personal appearance as app and the said William Morris at the then next County Court to be held for said County to wit the 16th day of June Anno Dom 1719 did not appear according to the Tenour of the Recognizance last said neither did he appear at this present Court to wit the 17th day of August to save himself and his app Baile. By which the said W^m Morris Recognizance for the Summe of twenty pound Sterling and the said Gideon Pearce his Surety in the Summe of Ten pounds Sterl are adjudg^d
