DEC'D by the Court here That the aff^t Joseph Wright enter into recognizance with Sundrys for his appearance to the next Court Joseph Wright aff^t comes into Court and Acknowledges himself Indebted to his Lord ship his Lord and Successors in the summe of Twenty pound Sterling to be payed on his goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if he do not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County and that he answer unto a certain judgment found against him Stealing too belonging to A Col in Richard Davis and in the meantime to be of good behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself Content.

Thomas Winn Son^t and John Ellwicks acknowledge themselves Indebted to his Lord ship his Lord and Successors in the summe of Ten pounds Sterl^E Each to be payed on their goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if the aff^t Joseph Wright shall not appear and Answer as afo^r and in the meantime he was to be of good behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves Content

His Lordship The aff^t William Morris entered into Recoginunce in the summe of twenty pounds Sterl^E Each for his Lordships Justices of the Peace for Sud County and at the said County Court he was to a abide the judgment of the said Court. But the aff^t William Morris at the then next Court being the 16th day of June anno Dom 1719 did not appear according to the tenour of his Recoginunce aff^t And now at this Court to wit the 19th day of August anno Dom 1719 The aff^t William Morris having solemnly agreed to make his appearance to his aff^t Recoginunce whereby he might save himself and his Baile being Mr Gideon Pearce who at the same time aff^t being the twenty sixth day of May anno Dom 1719, did make and pay the summe of Ten pounds Sterl^E to the use of the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietor conditionally that the said William Morris did not make his personal appearance as afo^r and the said William Morris at the then next County Court to be held for said County to wit the 16th day of June anno Dom 1719 did not appear according to the tenour of the Recoginunce last said Neither did he appear at this present Court to wit of 19th day of August to save himself and his aff^t Baile By paying the said Wm Morris Recoginunce for the summe of twenty pounds Sterl^E and the said Gideon Pearce his Security in the summe of Ten pounds Sterl^E aforesaid adjudged
