And the said Sarah Jewers by Michael Howard her attorney comes and defends the force and injury when &c. and saith that she doth not detain from the a<sup>o</sup> Lord Proprietary and the said James Harris who as well prosecuteth for his said Lord Ship as himselfe the a<sup>o</sup> two thousand pounds of Tobacco of the a<sup>o</sup> value of twenty pounds Sterling or any part thereof in forme as the a<sup>o</sup> James Harris (who as well for his said Lord Ship as himselfe prosecutes as a<sup>o</sup>) hath above against her Declared and of this she puts herself upon the Country &c. W. Howard of Defender

And the a<sup>o</sup> James Harris who as well for the Lord proprietor as for himselfe in this Case prosecutes in like Manner *Borne of J<sup>rs</sup>.*
