All which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of June Anno Domini 1719 comes againe as well the said fits by their atty aforesaid as the said Doff by her atty aforesaid and the said Sarah Powers by Michael Howard her attorney comes and defends the same and injury wherein he doth not detain from the said Lord Proprietary and the said James Harris who as well prosecuteth for his said Lordship as himself the aforesaid two thousand pounds of Tobacco of the aforesaid value of twenty pounds Sterling or any part thereof in forme as the said James Harris who as well for his said Lordship as himself prosecutes as also hath above against her Declaration of this she puts herself upon the Country he. Because as well he of which said precept the said Sheriff to wit Simon Waller Gent now heretofore this day to wit the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June Anno Domini 1719 makes return that he hath here ready twelve &c. As by his precept he was commanded and now here afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned comes againe as well the said fits by their atty aforesaid as the said Doff by her atty aforesaid and the Jurors of that Jury being impannelled who being called likewise came to wit Thomas Christian George Alies Thomas Heborn Ruth Waterman John Ashby John Rollinson Thomas Riker Ebenezer Blackiston Francis Lewis Richard West Edward Davis Thomas Price who being duly elected tried and sworn to say the truth in the promises upon their Oath do say that they stand for the Plaintiffs and that the said Sarah Powers doth detain from the said Lord Proprietary and the said James Harris who as well prosecutes for his said Lordship as himself the aforesaid two thousand pounds of Tobacco of the value of six pounds five Shillings & 8d. money in manner and forme as the aforesaid James Harris who as well for his said Lordship as for himself prosecutes as also hath above declared against her and find Damages thereupon fifteen pounds of Tobacco with cost of Sute the debt by her atty aforesaid
