Robert Dunn Junr appointed Constable of Longford Bay Lower indressed in the Room of Edw Beck Junr who is accordingly Sworn and also takes the Oath of Abjuration and Subscribes the Same as also the Oath

John Wells appointed overseer of the Roads viz from Hoale pane Road the Road from thence along the Road that Ed. Blay directed the Clearing to the Road that leads from Toward Means to the Church of Shrewsbury and from said Church the road that leads to Morgans Beck Mill

Matthews Day appointed over Seer of the Roads viz from Wolf Trap Bridge to Thomas Winds from Thomas Winds to Shrewsbury Church from the Cross Road leading from Toward Means to the Church from the said Road to Shrewsbury Town
