William Ruck of this County having a negro man called Francis being very aged and not capable of Lab^r or whereby to answer his maintenance It is Considered by the Justices here that the Said Master pay no Levy for the same for the future he being adjudged not capable of Labour to answer his maintenance

M^r Sam. Thomas Daniel Flinn James Greenwood John Aftle Viran Beck William Burk sworn as Jur^{or}. Sent to y^e Grand Jury Joseph Overit appointed overseer of the Roads viz. from Worton Town to Cecil Old Road and from Said Town to J. V.

Edward Jarvis brings a Serv. Boy of his named Patrick Looe brought into the Country by Cap^t Loveston to have his age adjudged to know when he is to pay Levy. On View of the Same It is Considered by the Justices here that the Said Patrick is adjudged to be fourteen years old and that he serve till he arrives at the age of Twenty one years the Said Patrick Looe having indentures to serve no longer
