1719 comes again as well his Lordship by his Clarke of Indictments
as also the afo^d Attorney Debruler in his proper person as before
defends the same and injury where he^s and says that he cannot giveth the
premises afo^d so as afo^d ag^t him sayd nor can he say but that he is guilty
of the fornication afo^d with the afo^d Mary Neale and is willing that judgm^t
should be entered ag^t him for his sinne afo^d on account of the same and afo^d
thereon accruing as also other costs and charges thereon arising Wherefore
it is considered by the Justices here the 19th day of Novemb^r anno Dom^m
1719 afo^d That the afo^d Anthony Debruler pay the sume of Thirty-
Shill^t Current money his fine for Committing fornication as afo^d informed
afo^d Confessed and also pay the sume of four hundred Sixty Two pounds
of tobacco costs by the Court here adjudged accruing on the premises afo^d

ordered by the Court the fine afo^d the three first shillings w^t was auowm^t done
ordered by the Court here that the afo^d Anthony Debruler pay the person
at whose house the said Mary Neale lay sume of two hundred pounds of
tobacco it being adjudged his part for trouble & disgrace and charges in being
in her to bed

ordered by the Court here that the afo^d Anthony Debruler pay the said Mary Neale the
sume of three hundred Twenty pd^s to be it being adjudged his part to pay for
keeping the child ward of afo^d Mary of nine the same year
