And the ap^d Deft^r by Thomas Boone his atty comes and defends the force and injury &c. And saving to himselfe all manner of Exceptions as well to the writ as to the Deed of the said p^tt prays liberty to imparte thereto and to answer at next Court which is granted the same time is given &c. p^tt also

Richard Cole - This being an action of Debt Commenced by the p^tt ag^t the said Deft^r wherein there issued a Copy of the Deed with the writ in the said action and wherein the Sheriff of Kent County to whom the writ in the same action was directed makes return thereof to the Court here on the third Tuesday in March to wit the fifteenth day of the same month Anno Dom^o 1719 being the day of return of said writ Indorsed Capi Corpus Copy of the Deed Serued in time of me Simon Winder Sheriff

Whereupon at the prayer of the p^tt by David Macbride his atty the Deft^r is adjudged to give Special Baile to the action ap^d and the Sheriff of Kent County keep the said George Gleaves in Safe Custody until he shall give Special Baile as ap^d. Whereupon William Ellis of Kent County Planter present here in Court undertakes for the said George Gleaves that in case the said Richard Cole shall obtain Judgment against the said George Gleaves in the plea ap^d or that the said George Gleaves shall be thereon Condemned that then he the said George Gleaves shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body to the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County in Satisfaction thereof or that the said William Ellis will do it for him

Kent County of George Gleaves of Kent County which weight was summoned to answer unto Richard Cole of Essex that he render him the full and just Summe of three pound Great Silver money of Maryland which to him he oweth and which from him he unjustly detains &c. And whereupon the ap^d p^tt by David Macbride his atty saith that whereas the ap^d Deft^r the twelfth day of August in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and Nineteen at Shrewsbury Parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which he the said Deft^r Sealed with his Seale and as his deed delivered hereto Court brought the date whereof is the same day and Year ap^d granted himselfe holden and firmly bound unto the ap^d p^tt in the ap^d full and just Summe of Three pounds Current Silver money of Maryland to be paid unto the ap^d p^tt at or upon the tenth day of November next ensuing the date of the said writing Obligatory Nevertheless the ap^d Deft^r at the often required by the Eleventh day of November in the Year ap^d at the parish County & Jurisdiction
