 & month & year ago at the Parish County Jurisdiction and upon himself
 assumed & to the said plt then and there faithfully promise that he the
 Deft the said sum of eight hundred pounds of Tobacco when thereunto
 required would well & truly paye Content never the less the said Deft his
 promise and assumption ago in no wise regarding but plotting & fraudulently
 intending the said sum of eight hundred pounds of Tobacco to be
 defraud he hath not minded or regarded. But the said sum of eight hundred
 pounds of Tobacco to the said plt altho often required he hath not rendered
 but that to him to render. Therefore hath denied to the damage of the said
 plt. one thousand pounds of Tobacco & thereupon he brings Suite to
 D Maubridge of Quod pias in Doct Regoe

Zachariah Browne of Kent County planter here present in Court undertake
 for the said Hugh Frezier that in case the said Richard Cole Dom of the
 said Benatus Smith shall recover Judgment in the plea ago against
 the said Hugh Frezier or that the said Hugh Frezier shall be therein
 Convinced that then he the said Hugh Frezier shall paye the Condemna-
 tion of the Court thereupon or render his body to the Custody of the Sheriff
 of said County in Satisfaction thereof or that the said Zachariah Browne
 will do it for him

Alld now at this Court to wit the 15 Day of March Anno Dom 1719
 here present the said Deft comes and defends the force and injury wherof
 and says that he cannot gainsay the plt his action ag. Deas ag. ag. him
 brought nor can he say but that the said plt ought to recover his
 Damages by Occupation of the premises ago to the sume of eight hundred
 pounds of Tobacco and Costs & Sute but that Execution may be Stayed
 untill the tenth day of November next ensuing which the said plt does
 not gainsay therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 15
 day of March Anno Dom 1719 ago that the said Richard Cole Dom. as
 ago recover against the said Hugh Frezier as well the sume of eight
 hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages ago & in forme ad Confessed as also the
 sume of Two hundred Sixty Three pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged
 to him for his Costs and Charges about his Suite in this behalfe expended
 and the Deft in mercy &c.

But that Execution of the Judgment ago Case as ago untill the tenth
 day of November next ensuing
 D. M. Richd Cole This being an action of Trespass of the Case Commened by the
 plt ag. the said Deft and wherein the Sheriff of Kent County
 John Jones to whom the writ in the same action was directed makes
 return thereof to the Court here on the third day
