*John Hendrickson* vs *Martin Fleming*  
This being an action of Debt for the sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco Commoed by the *pl't* as the said *Deft* and wherein there is a copy of the Deed with the writ in the said action and wherein the writ in the said action was directed to the Sheriff of Kent County who makes return thereof to the Court here on the third day in March to wit the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the same month Anno Dom 1719 being the day of return of said writ *Indors. Capi Corpore* Copy of the Deed is recorded in the Court of the said County.

Whereupon at the prayer of the *pl't* by his atty the said *Deft* is adjudged to give special baile to the action and the Sheriff of said County keep the said *Deft* in safe custody until he shall give special baile thereupon James Greenwood of Kent County planter present here in Court undertakes for the said *Martin Fleming* that in case the said *John Hendrickson* shall recover judgement in the plea and against the said *Martin Fleming* or that he the said *Martin Fleming* shall be therein convicted that then he the said *Martin Fleming* shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of said County in satisfaction thereof or that the said James Greenwood will do it for him.

*Martin Fleming* of Kent County planter also *Deft* *Martin Fleming* of said County was summoned to answer unto *John Hendrickson* of a plea that he render him the sum of six hundred pounds of good sound Marchentable Leaf Tobacco of the value of six pounds Sterling money which from him he unjustly detains &c and whereupon the *pl't* by *David Maubridge* his atty saith that whereas the said *Deft* the first day of June in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and nineteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory which he the said *Deft* sealed with his seal and as his deed
