And now here at this Court to wit the 15th day of March Anno Domini 1719
comes the aforesaid Defendant and defends the force and injury when v^t Alms says
that he cannot gainsay the plaintiff his action aforesaid as aforesaid. *He is ap. ag. him*
brought nor can he say but that the said plaintiff ought to recover his
Debt by Quotation of the premises aforesaid with cost of Suite which the said
plaintiff does not gainsay. Therefore it is ordered by the Justices here
the 15th day of March Anno Domini 1719 aforesaid That the said Edwards
Brooks recover against the said John Jones as well the sum of Six
hundred pounds of Tobacco his Debt aforesaid In forme aforesaid Confessed as also
the sum of Two hundred forty two pounds of Tobacco by the Court here
adjudged to him for his costs and charges about his Suite in this behalf
laid out and expended and the Debt in money &c
