hundred and nineteen at St. Pauls Parish in Kent County within the
Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory which he the said
Deft Sealed with his Seal and as his deed delivered here into Court
brought the date whereof is the same day & Year above mentioned
bound himself his heirs &c. to pay or cause to be paid unto the
aff^d p^{ty} his heirs &c. or assigns the aff^d just and full sum of
Six hundred pounds of good Sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco Clear of
ground leaves & all manner of trash wth well Seasoned Cask to contain the same of the
