the within named Samuel Peale John Carpenter & Company in part of the
within mentioned Sum of two thousand and four hundred pounds of Tobacco
and have made known to the same Thomas Tolley before William Pope &
Thomas Cook good & lawfull men of my Bailiwick that the said Thomas
Tolley be and appear at the time & place within mentioned to show
Cause if any he hath why condemnation of the same should not be made
according to Law as the within writ reciteth and requires

And the said Garnish by Michael Howard his atty comes and defends
the force and injury when he. and prays leave to inquire hereunto until
next Court when it is granted the same day is given the plea also

At which said next Court to wit the 16th day of June Anno Domini 1719
comes the aforesaid by their atty aforesaid as also the said Garnish by his said
atty but the said Cause was continued until next Court

At which said next Court to wit the 1st day of August Anno Domini
1719 comes againe the aforesaid by their atty aforesaid and the said Garnish
by his said atty but the said Cause was continued until next
