and Whereupon the afd Gilbert Falconer by Thomas Rowse his attly Complainis that whereas the afd John Jones the Nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred & Sixteen at S. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court. In Consideration that the said Gilbert Falconer at the Special Instance and Request of the said John Jones would pay to a Certain Thomas Volley or order five hundred pounds of Tobacco at twelve Shillings Current money of Maryland & hundred upon himselfe assumed and to the said Gilbert Falconer then and there faithfully promise that he the said John Jones would pay unto the said Gilbert in one months time after the said Nineteenth day of March the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco in good Tobacco or that if he the said John Jones should not pay to the afd Gilbert Falconer in months time after the said Nineteenth day of March the said sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco in good Tobacco that then he the said John Jones would pay to the said Gilbert Falconer as much Tobacco as at the rate of eight Shillings a hundred should amount to the sum of three pounds Current money of Maryland in November next ensuing the afd Nineteenth day of March and the afd Gilbert Falconer
