 Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his or their hands ought not
 to be condemned according to Law if to him or them it shall seem
 meet and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto
 our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and
 there this writ Witness Nathaniel Stinson Gent. Chief Justice of our
 said Court this 25. day of March in the fourth Year of our Dominion &c.
