 fully promised that he the said Deft. the ago sume of one pound one
 Shilling & Six pence to the said ptt. when thereunto afterwards
 he should be required would well & truly pay & content and that
 whereas also the ago Deft. afterwards by the twenty third day of
 June in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred
 and sixteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court in consideration that the ago ptt. at the like Special
 instance & request of the ago Deft. had paid for the said Deft &
 to the proper use & behoofe of the ago Deft. severall sumes of money
 amounting in the whole to seven Shillings & Six pence Current
 money of Maryland as by an Quo. hereto annexed upon himselfe
 assumed and to the said ptt. then & there last mentioned faith-
 fully promised that he the said Deft. the ago sume of seven
 Shillings & Six pence to the said ptt. when thereunto he should
 be required would well & truly pay & content and that whereas
 also the ago Deft. afterwards by the twenty second day of February
 in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
 sixteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court in consideration that the ago ptt. at the like Special
 instance and request of the ago Deft. had then and there last mentioned
 paid to the said Deft. and to the proper use & behoofe of the ago
 Deft. by the hands of a Certain William Braikin the sume of one
 pound two Shillings & Six pence Current money of Maryland upon
 himselfe assumed and to the said ptt. then and there last mentioned
 faithfully promised that he the said Deft. the ago sume of one pound
 two Shillings & Six pence to the said ptt. when thereunto required
 would well & truly pay & content Nevertheless the ago Deft. his
 promise and assumption ago in former made as to the ago severall
 sumes of money amounting in the whole to three pounds nine
